

DRESS CODE

All students in the sixth form are required to follow the school dress code **without exception**.

As Sixth Formers, are considered as positive role models and they must set an exemplary example to the lower year groups.

Satisfactory appearance should be one of neat, smart and tidy attire mirroring that of work at the office.

The following items of attire are considered as acceptable:

Note well, all underwear, cleavage, shoulders and upper thighs must be covered at all times.

Make-Up, Jewellery and Hair

- Make-up should be natural looking.
- Body art of any form is not permitted.
- Discreet jewellery is permissible.
- Piercings should be hidden apart from ear and nose studs - which should be small and discreet
- Hair should be of a natural colour and may not be extreme in style
- Nails should be natural looking – nail polish should be discreet

If a student arrives at school dressed inappropriately they will be sent to the Sixth Form office where Mrs Beels will aim to contact home to offer parents the opportunity to bring in a change of clothes. If this is not possible the student will

be sent home and will be expected to change their clothes and return to school promptly.
