Dear Parents / Carers

As it is moving towards autumn and winter, I thought it would be useful to give a reminder of what we expect in terms of school uniform.

- **Coats** - Students should be wearing plain winter coats in Black or Navy Blue. These should not be patterned or multi-coloured. Currently I am seeing a few Khaki Parkas and a few patterned coats, which do not fit with the uniform code.
- **Scarves** – Students again should be wearing plain Black or navy Blue scarves. Currently I am seeing some multi-coloured and blanket style scarves. These also do not fit with the dress code.
- **Shoes** – Again these should be simply plain Black shoes.

All of the above is set out in our uniform booklet which is on the schools website.

We will wait to push on this until after half-term in case any parents have items they need to purchase.

After half-term any items contravening this code will unfortunately need to be confiscated. However where the issue is school coats we will loan students coats in the interim.
