## It is expected that Staff...

- Model good behaviour
- Treat others as we wish to be treated
- Be polite and show mutual respect
- Be punctual for work, meetings and lessons
- o Be prepared and equipped for our day
- o Embrace our school ethos and engage with the organisation
- o Be familiar with school systems and consistent with their application
- Maintain a positive attitude to our work environment
- Show awareness of the needs of those around us
- Respond to communications appropriately and in a timely manner
- o Allow ourselves the opportunity to reflect on our professional role
- Use CPD to develop expertise
- Share good practice
- Welcome and support new practitioners to the school and profession
- Dress appropriately according to school policy
- Behave responsibly in and out of work, particularly in Watford and the local area;
   apply this principle to our use of social media (do not allow ourselves to be 'followed' or 'liked' by a student or their family)
- o Use the most secure privacy settings when using social media setting.
- o Discourage idle gossip or rumours with all stakeholders
- Create our personal brand of work life balance
- Use line managers as first point of contact seek help and advice
- Be mindful of the environment and discreet when discussing sensitive issues

## It is expected that towards pupils we should:

- Welcome students at the classroom door
- o Smile
- Start each lesson fresh and do not hold grudges
- Be prepared and punctual
- o Maintain an enthusiastic approach in every lesson
- o Be mindful of students and respect the difficulties they may experience
- Know who our students are and how to support their learning

- Provide suitable resources that match student's ability, and allow them to make progress
- o Maintain a respectful and calm approach when we address our students
- Follow our behaviour system consistently
- Show consistency, fairness and respect in how we treat our students. Avoid idle consequences or threats
- Listen to students and take their concerns seriously
- Give students confidence and foster self belief
- Respect diversity of culture and beliefs
- o Ensure students are calm and respectful of the environment, including school trips
- Set and maintain high expectations in the school environment
- o Provide a safe learning environment
- o Exercise caution when sharing sensitive/personal information
- Mark books regularly and provide feedback
- When contacting students only use school email
- Adhere to safeguarding procedures
- o Avoid discussing students negatively with individual students or the whole class
- o Avoid inappropriate conversations with colleagues in front of students
- o Remember we may be a friendly teacher but, not a friend
