Red Nose Day 2019 is just around the corner and we've decided to join in the fun.

To raise money, we're going to be holding lunch time activities across the week from **11th – 15th March 2019**. Each year group will have a dedicated lunch time where they will be able to participate in sponsors, hall stalls and teacher karaoke. During this time there will be a range of activities for them to take part in so we recommend that students bring a small amount of change with them. The activities they will be able to take part in include:

Students will be asked to make a suggested donation of £1. **Please note that students are not permitted to wear items that are inappropriate for the school environment and that no inappropriate shorts or revealing clothes will be permitted. Any students wearing such clothing will be sent home to change.**

The money we raise will be used to change countless lives, both here in the UK and worldwide. In fact, just £3 could pay for crayons, pencils, paint and paper for children living in a Serbian refugee camp. And £10 could cover the cost of 10 hot meals for a homeless person in the UK.
